

**Nearly 250 projects on 2018 Flood Bond**




**147 active projects & 50 are completed**

# P4 Building Resilient Infrastructure

## Completed Projects in Precinct 4

### ❖ Buffalo Bayou

- Constructed linear detention along 6.4 miles of Buffalo Bayou

### ❖ Kleb Woods Detention Basin

- Built a detention basin to reduce flooding risks in Little Cypress Creek watershed

### ❖ Project Brays

- Reduced flood risk by widening 21 miles of Brays Bayou

### ❖ Zube Park Detention Basin

- Excavated over 380 acre-feet of detention in the Bauer-Hockley Stormwater Detention Basin

# P4 Building Resilient Infrastructure

## *Active Projects in Precinct 4*

### ❖ Keegan's Bayou Project

- Planning
- Construction timeline: Q1 2026 – Q1 2027
- Will reduce flood risk for 500+ structures in 100-year floodplain

### ❖ Little Cypress Creek

- Preliminary engineering
- Channel conveyance improvements
- Frontier program

### ❖ Cypress Ditch Flood Mitigation Project

- In design
- Expanding detention capacity in ditches throughout Bellaire



## Burnett Bayland

- ❖ Premier park
- ❖ 9.8-acre detention basin
- ❖ Gulfton BRT

## ❖ Barbara Quattro Alief Forest


- 1,200 trees along
